VISUAL ARTS GUIDELINES

**** Guidelines for Judges and Participating Art Teachers**

All Artwork Will Be Judged Based On These Guidelines:

All entries will be judged based on the following 3 Criteria:

- 1) Technical Proficiency:** Ability to work fluently in a particular medium;
- 2) Originality:** An innovative approach to process, concept and subject matter;
- 3) Emergence of a Personal Vision:** Evidence of the artist's unique style, sensibility and perspective.

**note- a weighted point system is available to judges if needed for final selection process.

- Work must be fully executed by the student.
- Photographic images scanned or otherwise incorporated into a design or a composition must be the student's original work.
Exceptions: Collage and assemblage.
- Professionally published photos, art works, or pre-printed images (labels, magazine photos, etc.) and all dimensional objects or design ideas which suggest infringement of published materials, should not be considered.
- Studies that obviously are copied from master works or use of copyrighted characters **must not be considered for award.** Exceptions: Collage and assemblage.

*SHOW DISPLAY GUIDELINES, Judging and Awards Information

SPACE, PANELS, TABLES AND SHOWCASES

DUE TO SPACE RESTRICTIONS, TABLES AND PANELS MAY BE LIMITED.

***BE PREPARED TO ANTICIPATE LOSS OF SPACE IF IT BECOMES UNAVAILABLE.**

PANEL DEFINITION

3 - 4 FT BY 8 FT PANEL MAY BE ONE FREE STANDING UNIT OR TWO HINGED DOORS TOGETHER

****Please be aware that each School / District is responsible to supply their own panels for their artwork. The library has some tables we can use, as well as ledges and the surface on top of bookshelves on the first floor. Artwork for these areas must be propped or freestanding.**

- Schools with less than 1500 students - 4 panels which equals 8 sides
- Schools with 1500 or more students - 8 panels which equals 16 sides
- Jersey City - 16 panels which equals 32 sides, since they are a very large district

** NEW LABEL ALERT

Each school has been assigned a color for your labels. In order to to make it easier for your students and the judges to identify your school, please make sure all your work has your color coded label.

Bayonne – Golden Rod 8 panels (16 sides)
County Prep – White 4 panels (8 sides)
Harrison – Purple 4 panels (8 sides)
Hi Tech - Cream 4 panels (8 sides)
Hoboken – Neon 4 panels (8 sides)
Hudson Catholic - Orange 4 panels (8 sides)
Jersey City – Light Blue - 16 panels (32 sides)
Kearny – Turquoise 8 panels (16 sides)
Marist – Brown 4 panels (8 sides)
Memorial – Yellow 8 panels (16 sides)
North Bergen – Red 8 panels (16 sides)
Union City – White 8 panels (16 sides)
Weehawken – Pink 4 panels (8 sides)
University Charter- White 4 panels (8 sides)
Hoboken Charter – Lime Green 4 panels (8 sides)

You may also post your School Title on Board displays and tables – to assist judges and visitors using your color.

If you design your own labels, please make sure you include the following on your colored label:

SCHEDULE OF TIMES

Schools may drop off beginning Thursday, May 2 at 9:00AM when the library opens.

The Free Public Library and Cultural Center of Bayonne is on the corner of Avenue C and 31st Street. There is a service entrance in the lot on 31st street in the alley. You may unload only. Once unloaded, you may park behind the library in the Municipal Parking in the evening. Street parking across Avenue C requires a city permit. Be mindful of the signs.

SHOW DISPLAY GUIDELINES, Judging and Awards Information

1. Due to yearly changes in available space at the Free Public Library and Cultural Center of Bayonne and the number of Participating Schools all spatial allocations and limitations on work will be made using the following criteria.
2. Schools must color code their labels. All artwork must be clearly labeled with all information.

JUDGE GUIDELINES

- ALL AWARDS shall be called “JUDGES AWARDS”- (Ribbon and Certificate).
- Artwork will not be judged in category.
- Each school will be judged against its own artwork
- 5 Judges Awards will be given to outstanding student work for schools with population under 1,000 students.
- 10 Judges awards will be given to outstanding student work for schools with a population over 1,000 students.

- Jersey City: Up to 5 awards for each school, totaling up to 25 awards.
- Every art student entry both in Performing and Visual will receive a “Certificate of Participation”.
- Each School District representative will select one “Top Honors” entry to receive a Certificate and Ribbon and a Gift Card (\$30.00)
Jersey City will receive three “Top Honors” Awards for the entire district.
- Judging will be on Tuesday May 7. Judges will be a group of professional artists and educators. (Assisted by Maya, Bill, Gerard and Bridget)
- Please do not call for award results, they will be forwarded to you via email or school representative. Please reply promptly with student name spelling corrections to Maya as she will be printing out the Award Display panel.
****We will be sending a photo of the award’s results via text message so that the information can be distributed more efficiently. Everyone will still need to email spelling corrections ASAP.*
- An Awards Ceremony will be held on Thursday–May 9, 2019 at 7:00PM – In the lobby of the Library and Cultural Center of Bayonne
